

LCBDD THANKS COMMUNITY FOR SUPPORT MAKING 2016 FLOWER SALE A SUCCESS

The board met in regular session on Thursday, May 19, 2016. Superintendent Saul Bauer thanked the local community for their support during the annual flower sale. Sales were down for the entire event until the final week of the sale. The final week was fantastic and resulted in us having our largest profit ever. We sold 534 baskets and 211 flats with a grand total of 745 orders. The sales resulted in \$4,485.97 profit that will go into the auxiliary fund and help individuals with developmental disabilities. Special thanks was given to Jenifer Schreiner for her coordination and hard work on this fundraiser and all of the volunteers who made this event so successful.

In other board business the board approved the renewal of four contracts with Midwest Regional Educational Service Center effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. They were for the following: Automatic Sub Finder Services (AESOP), Licensed Professional Development Committee (LPDC), Resident Educator Services & Public Relations Coordinator Services.

In personnel issues before the board Mr. Bauer announced the promotion of Gary Morris from a custodian to the Maintenance Supervisor position effective April 25, 2016. Candidates were also interviewed last week to fill an Instructor Assistant position and to hire another intermittent sub for custodians, cook assistants, and secretarial vacancies when needed.

Logan County Board of Developmental Disabilities was presented a plaque from the Community Blood Center (CBC) for being a Gold partner. During 2015 LCBDD collected 99 units of blood, hosted 4 blood drives and averaged 110% of our blood drive goals. Each donation made can save up to three lives. Our next blood drive will be on Wednesday July 13, 2016 at the Discovery Center from 1-4 pm.
