LOGAN COUNTY BOARD OF DD BEGINS CHICKEN BBQ TICKET SALES

The Logan County Board of Developmental Disabilities Board discussed the LCDD Foundation's Chicken BBQ at their board meeting Thursday August 18, 2016. This year celebrates their 29th Annual Chicken BBQ. This delicious meal will be served Thursday October 6th from 11:30 am to 7 pm. The menu consists of the famous Port A Pit ½ BBQ chicken, applesauce, chips, cookie, roll and butter. The meal is only \$8 and tickets can be purchased from any LCBDD or RTC Industries, Inc. employee or board member. Orders of five or more meals can be delivered. In order to make it more convenient for our customers who do not carry cash, purchases can be made the day of the BBQ with a credit card. Checks can be made out to the LCBDD Auxiliary Foundation Committee. Proceeds from this event are used to better serve individuals with developmental disabilities in Logan County. Proceeds have been used to purchase tombstones for deceased clients who have no family, purchase Christmas presents for the children at the Discovery Center, purchase books at the book fair for children, client Christmas celebrations, assist clients with rent or utilities, medical transportation, levy and other services.

Superintendent Saul Bauer welcomed new staff back as they begin the 2016-2017 School Year. All of the Discovery Center Staff returned to work on Wednesday August 17, 2016 with the children returning on August 22nd & 24th. One new Instructor Assistant, Sherri Ullom, also joined the staff this week after completing her New Hire Orientation.

In financial business we are 58% through the year on expenses and the general fund is 48.72% utilized. The Community Support Fund is 52.95% utilized. The revenues are 58% through the year and we are 87.98% collected. The capital fund is 100% collected while the Community Support Fund is 79.60% collected. Year to date expenses in the general fund are 8% lower than this time last year and year to date revenue in the general fund is 41% higher than this time last year.

In other board business the board approved a revision to the Tuition Reimbursement Policy, the Drug and Alcohol Policy, and the new Behavior Support Policy. The board also approved the renewal of the Ohio Self Determination Association for the 2016-2017 school year for a professional membership and 15 self-advocate memberships.

Superintendent Bauer reviewed several contracts approved by the board including a contract with CORSP for the Food Service Assistant Agreement September 1, 2016 through September 1, 2017, an Interagency Agreement effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. The FCFC Help Me Grow contract effective July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 and the FCFC Administrative Funding Agreement for the same time period.

The next finance committee meeting is scheduled for September 12th at noon at the Logan County Board of DD board office conference room at 1851 State Route 47 West, Bellefontaine. The next board Meeting takes place on Thursday, September 15th at 5:30 pm in the board office conference room. These meetings are open to the public.
