The Logan County Board of Developmental Disabilities Board discussed their 28<sup>th</sup> Annual Chicken BBQ at their board meeting Thursday August 20, 2015. This delicious meal will be served Thursday October 8<sup>th</sup> from 11:30 am to 7 pm. The menu consists of the famous port a pit ½ BBQ chicken, applesauce, chips, cookie, roll and butter. The meal is only \$8 and tickets can be purchased from any LCBDD employee or board member. Orders of five or more meals can be delivered. In order to make it more convenient for our customers who do not carry cash purchases can be made the day of the BBQ with a credit card. Checks can be made out to the LCBDD Auxiliary Foundation Committee. Proceeds from this event are used to purchase Christmas presents for the children at the Discovery Center, purchase books at the book fair for children, adult services client Christmas party, purchase a tombstone for a deceased client who has no family, assist clients with a loan for rent or utilities, repair a car for client medical transport, levy and other services.

Superintendent Saul Bauer welcomed new staff as we begin the 2015-2016 School Year. Employees that began work on Monday August 17, 2015 were: Instructor Assistant Gail Hawley, Instructors Stacey Everhart & Donna Johnson. Instructor Janet Yoder will postpone her retirement a couple of months and will work in the gymnasium until our Contract with Northwest Therapy will begin on November 1, 2015. Part-time COTA Kathy Foust will be rehired September 1, 2015 and Fran Smith began as a contractor on August 1, 2015. Sandra Bowsher will begin August 21, 2015 as a cook assistant. Three additional positions have offers on the table and should be filled shortly.

In financial business we are 58% through the year on expenses and the general fund is 48% utilized. The revenues are 58% through the year and we are 57% collected.

In other board business the board approved a revision to policy 5.7.5 Fringe Benefits and the definition of part-time. An annual Corporate Sponsorship with Kiwanis was approved along with the 2016 Administration Calendar.

Superintendent Bauer reviewed several contracts approved by the board including a contract with CORSP for the Food Service Assistant Agreement September 1, 2015 through September 1, 2016, a contract with CDC for the County Board Funded Admission Agreement, a contract with RTC for Carryover Employee Contract, the new Contract between LCBDD and RTC effective 1/1/15 and the board approved funding for the Transition Plan.

The next finance committee meeting is scheduled for September 14<sup>th</sup> at noon at the Logan County Board of DD board office conference room at 1851 State Route 47 West, Bellefontaine. The next board Meeting takes place on Thursday, September 17<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 pm in the board office conference room. These meetings are open to the public.
