We have allocated a direct line for everyone to call in and hear weather information regarding school or RTC delays or cancellations. **Please dial 292-3096 for current weather information.**

Although we refer to local school districts' delay and cancellation information, there are important differences in our decisions to delay or cancel programs. For example, due to the earlier bus routes of local schools, their one hour delay is equal to the regular starting time for our bus routes. Our first priority in all decisions will be the safety and welfare of students and RTC Associates. There may be days when we will close the Discovery Center and RTC Industries when local schools and businesses are open.

There may be occasions when the Discovery Center is closed and RTC Industries remains open. Sometimes transportation may be limited to persons residing in the city, depending upon road conditions. If at any time we remain open during inclement weather and a person enrolled or their family does not believe it is safe to attend, they may choose to stay at home, but please call to let us know.

Staff is to follow the Board policy on calamity days. Here's to a safe winter for all!
