Logan County Board of Developmental Disabilities



The Logan County Board of DD provides guidance and assistance for individuals with developmental disabilities and their families. Our services span a lifetime, from birth through early childhood, adulthood, and retirement. We are honored to offer the following services.

### **Early Intervention**

Early Intervention assists families in meeting the unique needs of their children 0-3 and may include home visits, special instruction, child development information and other family supports.

### Discovery Center Preschool

Provides services to children ages 3-5, in an integrated preschool setting with specialized instruction and educational based speech, occupational, and physical therapy. Developing children's self-esteem, respect for others, and confidence in their abilities to problem solve are priorities in the curriculum and in practice. It is the goal of staff to foster independence and creativity in all areas of learning so young children may know the joy of discovery.

# Services to School Age Children

Includes service coordination and locating necessary resources to meet identified needs. We recognize that the needs of individuals vary depending on their age and realize that the needs of school age children are unique. We are committed to providing supports to school age children and their families to the best of our ability while encouraging and supporting community integration. We also assist with transition planning and special programming that includes but is not limited to: Families Touched by Autism, Teen Summer Programming, Friday Night Outs, and the RISE (Recreation, Independence, Skills and Exploration) program.

## Service and Support Administration

The primary support service coordination for individuals with developmental disabilities eligible for County Board of DD Services. The Service and Support Administrators (SSA) assess an individual's needs and identify supports that will emphasize a good life, dignity and respect, community inclusion with quality staff and services. SSA supports may span throughout a lifetime.

### Services for Adults

Services Coordination for housing, benefits, employment, transportation, providers, community integration and much more. Services are coordinated with the needs of individuals in mind. Employment, vocational, day habilitation, seniors and recreational services are available. Individuals may be connected to those services by working with their SSA.

### **Support Services**

Support Services are available to families who have a family member living in their home who is eligible for County Board Services. The goal is to keep families together and help them experience enduring relationships as a family. Financial assistance may be provided for respite care, counseling, medical expenses, adaptive equipment, and anything else that relates to the individual's disability that provides support to the family. We also provide varying levels of supervision and support to eligible individuals to live in community settings of their choice.

### **Special Olympics**

We support Special Olympics teams which include, but are not limited to: Basketball, Bowling, Equestrian, Track and Field, Cheerleading and Softball.

### **Community Integration**

We support community integration with Community First, supporting self-advocacy through Project STIR, where graduates learn to express their own desires and goals.
