## Our Services At-A-Glance



### Early Intervention (EI)

Serves infants and toddlers year-round, up to age 3 with a developmental delay or qualifying medical condition. Team members partner with parents and caregivers in their natural environment to support children as they grow and learn. EI builds upon the family's strengths and resources to help enhance a child's development in their everyday routines.



### Discovery Center Preschool

Children aged 3-5 are integrated in a preschool setting with specialized teachers and therapists. The goal is to foster independence and creativity in learning so young children may know the joy of discovery! Friday Nights Out is a program offered by LCBDD, geared towards preschool children.



### School-Aged Children

As children navigate school and the transition years, service coordination and identifying needs and resources becomes priority. Programs are offered for school-aged children including Teen Summer Programming.



### Adult Support Services

Adults that are eligible for services are assigned a Service & Support Administrator (SSA). The SSA works with the person to identify needs, wants and desires. From there, they aid in coordinating housing, employment, benefits, and more!

### Special Olympics

We provide a variety of athletic opportunities for individuals with disabilities in Logan County. Currently we offer basketball, bowling, equestrian, track and field, cheerleading, flag football, and softball.



### Family & Community Opportunities
